



PANELIST CONTRACT

OTAFEST 2019

MAY 17 - 19, 2019

CALGARY TELUS CONVENTION CENTRE

The application for a panel at Otafest 2019 will become a contract between the Otafest Film and Cultural Festival Planning Committee (Otafest) and the applicant (Panelist). By submitting an application for a panel at Otafest 2019 the Panelist agrees to the terms and conditions set forth in the Otafest 2019 Panelist Contract (this document). The information contained within the following contract may be updated or amended at the discretion of Otafest.

1. GENERAL GUIDELINES

- a. The Panelist must provide a detailed description of the content of their panel during the submission process, should the content presented in the submission form conflict with the content observed during the panel, The Panelist will not be allowed to present at future events hosted by Otafest.
- b. The content of the Panelist's presentation must be appropriate for the age category it is placed in. Coarse language, excessive violence, nudity and/or partial nudity are not acceptable *unless* the panel is rated as '18+'.
 - i. No presentation, regardless of whether it is rated as '18+' or not, will contain any depictions, reference to, or images of underage characters or persons in the nude, performing any sexual act, or in any other circumstance considered unlawful.
- c. The Panelist must check in no later than 1 hour prior to the start of their presentation. The Panelist must accompany all assistants when they pick up their pass to verify eligibility.
- d. There is a minimum 30-minute break between panels. The Panelist will arrive early to ensure that all equipment required for the presentation is set up and is in working order prior to the start time of the presentation.
- e. The Panelist will finish the content of their presentation by the listed end time.
- f. The Panelist will engage in appropriate behavior towards all assistants, volunteers, attendees, staff members, and any member of the general public. Failure to do so may result in the Panelist being ejected and banned from presenting at future events held by Otafest.
- g. The Panelist and all assistants must be at least 18 years of age if their presentation is deemed '18+'. No exceptions.
 - i. All attendees at 18+ presentations are required to provide a piece of photo identification before they will be granted entrance to the room/area of the presentation.
- h. The Panelist is responsible and accountable for the actions of all assistants and persons involved in the running of their presentation.

2. WAITLIST POLICY

- a. If there are more panel applications than scheduled time for Otafest 2019, Otafest may add the Panelist to a waitlist.
- b. If the Panelist is placed on the waitlist, they must be prepared to provide a copy of their presentation without issue or delay if notified that their application has been accepted.

3. CANCELLATIONS

- a. The Panelist is expected to run their presentation at the scheduled time. Should the Panelist be unable to run the presentation, they must notify the panels coordinator at panels@otafest.com prior to May 4th, 2019 with a valid reason, failure to do so may result in the Panelist being banned from presenting at future events held by Otafest. All cancellations are handled on a case by case basis.

4. DISCOUNT POLICY

- a. The Panelist and one (1) assistant (Primary Assistant) are entitled to a discounted weekend pass to Otafest 2019, the price of this pass is \$20.00.
 - i. If the Panelist and/or the Primary Assistant have pre-purchased a weekend pass online, they will be reimbursed for the amount they paid for the pass less \$20.00 by the panels coordinator at Otafest 2019.
- b. If the Panelist is the host or Primary Assistant for any 2 or more presentations they will be granted free admission to Otafest 2019.
 - i. If the Panelist and/or the Primary Assistant have pre-purchased a weekend pass online, they will be reimbursed for the full amount they paid for the pass by the panels coordinator at Otafest 2019.
- c. Discounts apply only to weekend passes. The discounts do not apply to Otafest's Youth Pass, Child Pass, Angel Pass, or any other "special" Otafest passes.
- d. The Panelist may have up to 10 assistants, however these assistants are **not** entitled to the discount described above and **will not** be provided with complementary lanyards and badges.

5. EQUIPMENT

- a. Equipment needs will be addressed on a case by case basis and requested equipment is always subject to availability. It is ultimately the responsibility of the Panelist to provide any and all required equipment to ensure the success of their presentation.

6. DISCLAIMER

- a. Otafest reserves the right to approve, deny, reschedule, or cancel any presentation at any time as Otafest deems fit.
- b. Otafest accepts no responsibility or liability for the content of presentations hosted by the Panelist, assistants, or other attendees.
- c. Otafest does not extend any form of legal protection to the Panelist. The Panelist is entirely responsible for ensuring the legality and safety of the content presented in their presentation.
